



Fast Facts: ABORTION IN CA

Roughly 179,650 babies were **aborted** in the State of California last year.

The Stats

- There are at least 176 pregnancy centers in CA, compared to about 166 abortion-providing clinics (nearly 25% of the total number in the country).
 - However, as of 2020, there were over 415 abortion-providing facilities in the state (clinics, hospitals, and physicians' offices).
- There has been an increase from 16 per 1k women to 22.5 abortions per 1k women since 2017.
- Medicated abortions have increased by 18% since 2022.
- CA has dedicated over \$200 million to “reproductive healthcare” since 2022.
- Within the last six months, an average of 15,380 clinician-provided abortions occurred each month.

Reality

Abortion numbers in California are up 16% since 2020, even post-*Dobbs*.

Chemical abortions account for 63% of abortions, which can be obtained *without* attending a brick-and-mortar clinic. Women can obtain abortion prescriptions from over 93 facilities which *only* provide medicated abortions.

Current bills include making it difficult to deny the establishment of Planned Parenthoods in cities and spending even more public funding promoting abortion access.

The State of Abortion Legislation

- Abortion has been protected in the CA Constitution thanks to Prop 1, which was passed in 2022.
- The CA legislature has been on a consistent push to discredit and limit the influence and success of pregnancy clinics.
- Since 2022, Gov. Newsom has created a state abortion database, covered uninsured abortions, and provided funding for logistics such as travel for rural patients.
